

MassMedLine Participates In First Life Sciences Day At State House

On May 21st at the State House, MassMedLine participated in the first Life Sciences Day, hosted by the Massachusetts Biotech Caucus and PhRMA. Mary Sullivan, director of MassMedLine, and Jennifer Fradette, a sixth-year pharmacy student who is currently on rotation with the Office of Government Affairs & Continuing Education, were on hand to speak about MassMedLine's services with pharmaceutical representatives, elected officials and staff from the Massachusetts Biotechnology Council.
